

Local Union 520 Scholarship Program 2018-2019

Registration Form

Purpose of Program

The program was began in September 2015. Under the direction of the LU 520 C.O.P.E., its goal is to encourage apprentices to become more involved with L.U. 520 activities. Apprentices registered and complete the required activities during the current school year will have their books and tuition monies for that current school year reimbursed.

Current School Year : September 1, 2018 -August 31, 2019

Definitions

C.O.P.E.- Committee on Political Education

A.E.T.A.- Austin Electrical Training Alliance formerly Austin Electrical JATC

Member in good standing- individual is not indebted to the Local Union for more than three months' dues, or having any other indebtedness (such as for death benefits) to the Local Union more than three months in arrears

Elective activities- Extra-curricular activities approved by the C.O.P.E. committee

Lead Person- individual who is responsible for verifying the attendance of participating individuals of the L.U. 520 Scholarship Program at elective activities

Eligibility

To participate in the program, each Participant:

1. Must be registered with the L.U. 520 Scholarship Program for the current school year
2. Must be enrolled in the A.E.T.A.
3. Must be a "Member in good standing" with I.B.E.W. L.U. 520
4. No reimbursements will be made if the participant withdraws from the A.E.T.A. on his own accord or is dropped by the A.E.T.A. Committee during the current school year.

Requirements

Each participant is required to:

1. ***This registration form must be completed and turned into the C.O.P.E. Committee before any activities will be counted.***
2. Be a member in good standing and remain current on all monthly dues to L.U. 520 for the duration of each current school year
3. Be a member in good standing and remain current with no more than 3 Death Benefits in arrears payable to L.U. 520 for each current school year
4. Attend 7 regular monthly Union meeting during the current school year
5. Meet all requirements for advancement in the apprenticeship program
6. Attend and complete the L.U. 520 New Member Orientation class (N.M.O. Parts I & II)
If you have completed the N.M.O. Parts I & II prior to the current school year and it is recorded with the Hall, you will be credited.
7. Complete 4 elective activities.

Elective Activities

Elective activities include:

1. Participate as committee member (must be appointed by President of LU 520 to specific committee's)
2. Participate LU activities
(e.g. L.U. 520 Picnic, Habitat for Humanity, A.F.L.-C.I.O. Fish Fry, neighborhood walks, political rallies, etc.)
3. L.U. 520 Education Classes
(e.g. Steward Training, Voter Registration, Code of Excellence)
4. Act as lead person for an elective activity approved by the L.U. 520 C.O.P.E.
*****It is important to note that the C.O.P.E. will announce other elective activities during the current school year*****

Reimbursement Awards

Beginning with the June union meeting, awards will be presented to those who complete the required activities. In order for a candidate to be eligible to receive an award at the regular union meeting all activities must be completed before the last day of the previous month (e.g., candidates who complete all activities prior to May 31st will receive awards on or after the night of the June meeting).

No late fees are eligible for reimbursement!
